Instagram Feed plugin uses Instagram API on website front end. All the data received from Instagram via API is cached in WordPress database for some short period to provide front end optimization. You may request us to delete your Instagram data if it is accidentally cached in our website database with hashtag feed data. Instagram saves some cookies in browsers of website visitors via API data.

Cookies adopted are mostly used for security purposes. They are regulated under terms of Instagram's <u>Privacy Policy</u>.

## **Plugin: Smush**
